### **News of progress with the Vacancy**

The Bishop of Ely and the Diocesan Officers have approved the proposals put forward in our Parish Profile and Statement that was offered for consultation and confirmed by the congregation for the arrangements for the ministry of the Parish once the current vacancy has come to an end.

The Diocese will support Saint Botolph's continuing as a single benefice (parish) with a Priest-in-Charge, working part-time on a non-stipendiary basis. Given the size and other characteristics of our Parish, as well as the lack of stipend, the person appointed would be expected to combine the duties of Priest-in-Charge with employment or other commitments and activities.

The process for specifying the post's nature and responsibilities, derived from the Parish Profile and Statement, and for recruitment and selection, is the responsibility of a designated group of PCC members\*, together with the advice and approval of the Archdeacon of Cambridge and the Rural Dean.

This designated group has started their work. It is too soon to say how much longer the current Vacancy will continue. The PCC will make sure that the parish and congregation are kept fully informed about progress.

I offer my warmest appreciation and thanks to my colleagues who are working very hard throughout the Vacancy to shape and ensure the

future for Saint Botolph's.
